You have full control over cookie settings in your browser. You can:

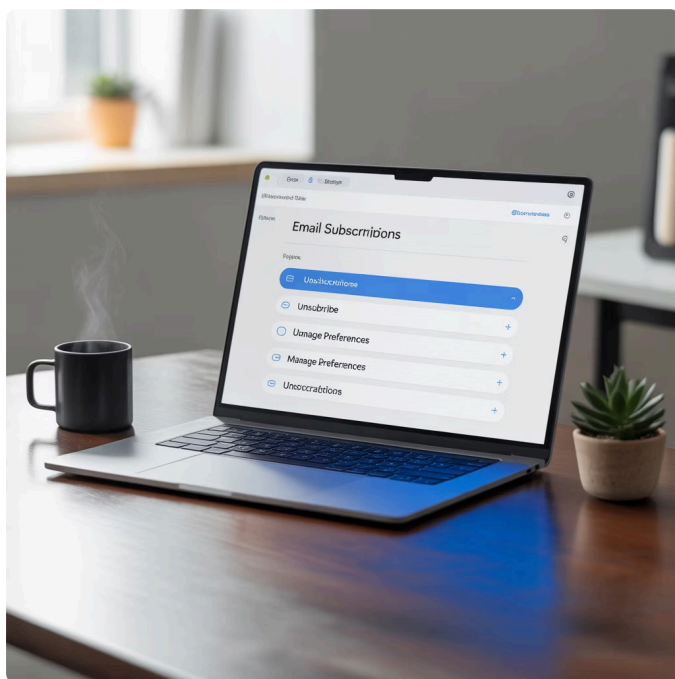

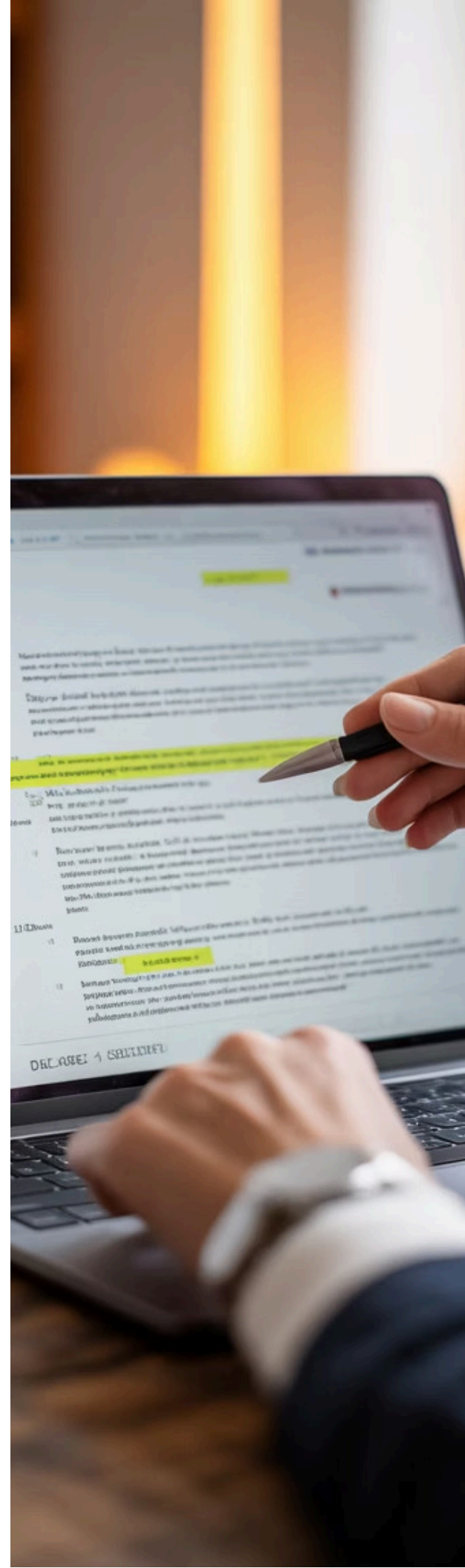
